This event will take place at the Vivid Ideas Exchange in The Balcony Room at the University of Technology, Sydney (U.T.S)

Getting there by Bus

- The bus stop directly outside the venue, on Broadway, is called "University of Technology Sydney, Broadway, Ultimo", Stop ID 200723.
- Cross a courtyard to the main doors of U.T.S. Tower 1. It's about 18 metres.
- In the lobby, take a lift to the 5th floor. There will be people available to provide directions and an escort if necessary.

Getting there by Train/Railway Square

- From Central Station's South Concourse, follow the Devonshire tunnel to Railway Square, and keep going straight ahead through the second tunnel that passes under George Street.
- Go up the escalators and turn left, following George Street away from the CBD.
- Keeping the same direction, cross Harris Street, which is where George Street becomes Broadway.
- After about another 110 metres along Broadway, turn right and cross a courtyard to the main doors of U.T.S. Tower 1. It's about 18 metres.
- In the lobby, take a lift to the 5th floor, or go up two flights of stairs to the next level. There will be people available to provide directions and an escort if necessary.

Access

This event will be captioned, Auslan interpreted and is wheelchair accessible.

Toilets

Male, female and accessible amenities are located opposite the Great Hall on level 5. The distance between the Great Hall and the toilets is approximately 50 metres.

Bar

There's a bar in The Balcony Room which adjoins The Great Hall and overlooks Alumni Green. It sells drinks and snacks which can be taken into The Great Hall. Please note that the bar is cashless.

Dog toileting:

- Alumni Green, a long lawn, is the best place to toilet dogs.
- The Balcony Room bar overlooks Alumni Green.
- Outside the Great Hall, take the lift down to level 3, or go downstairs two floors. The Green is out the back doors onto the green. The grassed area is slightly elevated from the main walkway. There might also be people picnicking and relaxing on the grass.
- There are plenty of toilets or water fountains around for the dogs to get water.
